## ORDER UNDER SECTION 32.

CUPAR DISTRICT COMMITTEE of the County Council of the County of Fife, as Local Authority under the Public Health (Scotland) Act, 1897, within the Cupar District of the said County do, by this their Order made under and in virtue of the powers contained in Section 32 (1) of the said Act, declare that the businesses of bone degreaser and manufacturer of meat meal and other products of like nature manufactured from the flesh, bones, viscera, or offal, of horses or cattle shall be offensive businesses under and within the meaning of Section 32 (1) of the said Act.
