

the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands, and Isle of Man) Order of 1923, as amended by the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands, and Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order of 1927, except that the animals shall not be moved from the landing place, and shall be slaughtered therein within ninety-six hours after their landing.

Slaughter of fat animals already detained in Landing Places.

2. Animals intended for immediate slaughter which are in any approved Landing Place in Great Britain at the date of this Order shall be slaughtered within ninety-six hours after such date, and the Orders referred to in Article 1 of this Order shall be read and have effect subject to this amendment.

Offences.

3. Any person committing, or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order, is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927.

Revocation.

4. The Animals (Landing from Ireland and Isle of Man) Order of 1928 (No. 5) is hereby revoked.

Local Authority to enforce Order.

5. The provisions of this Order, except where it is otherwise provided, shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Short Title.

6. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND AND ISLE OF MAN) ORDER OF 1928 (No. 6).

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 4TH AUGUST 1928.)

ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND AND ISLE OF MAN) ORDER OF 1928 (No. 7).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power

enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Revocation.

1. The Animals (Landing from Ireland and Isle of Man) Order of 1928 (No. 6) is hereby revoked.

Release of Fat Animals detained in Landing Places.

2. Any animal subject to the provisions of the Order referred to in Article 1 of this Order in any approved Landing Place in Great Britain at the commencement of this Order shall thereafter be subject to the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man) Order of 1923, as amended by the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order of 1927.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation at midnight on the fourth/fifth day of August nineteen hundred and twenty-eight.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND AND ISLE OF MAN) ORDER OF 1928 (No. 7).
