

and terminating at a point on the north side of the public road from Dores to Dunlichity two hundred yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the said farm steading.

WORK No. 9.—A gauge chamber wholly in the Parish of Dores situate at the termination of the conduit or line of pipes (Work No. 8) hereinbefore described at a point two hundred yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the farm steading of Midtown.

WORK No. 10.—A conduit or line of pipes wholly in the Parish of Dores commencing by a junction with the gauge chamber (Work No. 9) hereinbefore described at a point two hundred yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the farm steading of Midtown thence proceeding in a northerly direction for a distance of five hundred and eighty yards or thereabouts and terminating at a point on the margin of Loch Ashie seven hundred and seventy yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the said farm steading.

WORK No. 11.—A conduit or line of pipes wholly in the Parish of Dores commencing by a junction with the gauge chamber (Work No. 9) hereinbefore described at a point two hundred yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the farm steading of Midtown thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction for a distance of two thousand seven hundred and seventy yards or thereabouts and terminating by a junction with the existing supply pipe from Loch Ashie to the service reservoir at a point twenty yards or thereabouts measured in an easterly direction from the existing screening chamber on the said supply pipe.

WORK No. 12.—A road of access wholly in the Parish of Dores commencing by a junction with the public road from Dores to Dunlichity at a point one hundred and seventy yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the farm steading of Midtown thence proceeding in a south-westerly and south-easterly direction for a distance of seven hundred and eighty yards or thereabouts and terminating at the pumping station (Work No. 7) hereinbefore described.

Powers of deviation; Further powers as to laying mains and pipes within and outside water limits; Consolidation of existing waterworks with waterworks to be authorised; Definition and extension of limits of supply and of compulsory supply.

To authorise the Corporation by means of the intended Waterworks and the existing Waterworks of the Corporation or one or other or some part or parts of the same to abstract intercept divert take appropriate impound collect store distribute supply and use for the purposes of the Order:—The waters of Loch Duntelchaig and Loch nan Geadas situated in the Parishes of Dores and Daviot and Dunlichity and County of Inverness and all lochs streams or tributaries the waters of which drain or flow into the said lochs and all waters springs and streams flowing directly or indirectly into the said lochs above the site of the Embankment or Dam (Work No. 2) before mentioned.

All which waters of said lochs and others above described now flow into the outlet stream known as Allt Eadar dha Lochan thence into Loch a Chlachain and thence into the stream known as Allt a Chlachain which flows into the River Nairn and thence into the sea.

To empower the Corporation to raise and lower or regulate the level of the water in Loch Duntelchaig and Loch nan Geadas as the Order may provide.

To provide if deemed expedient for compensation water being given in respect of the proposed taking of water under the powers of the Order or to make such other provision as to compensation as the Order may provide.

Appointment of Committee of Riparian Proprietors and conferring powers on such Committee; Actings and decisions of such Committee to be binding on Riparian Proprietors;

Compulsory acquisition and user of lands &c.; Compulsory acquisition &c. of servitudes; Exemption from Section 90 of Lands Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845; Extinguishing rights of way over lands; Power to dispose of surplus lands; Stopping up &c. of roads &c.; Power to acquire and hold lands and construct works for prevention of pollution; Discharge of water into streams &c.

Further borrowing powers in respect of water and gas undertakings; Rates rents assessments and charges.

Bye-laws Regulations &c.; Penalties; Agreements and confirmation thereof.

Incorporation application and amendment or repeal of Acts and Orders and other purposes.

The Order will confer all other powers and make all other provisions which may be necessary or expedient for carrying into effect the objects powers and purposes thereof all as the Order may provide.

Notice is hereby also given that plans and sections and duplicates thereof respectively describing the lines situations and levels of the Works proposed to be authorised as before-mentioned and the lands and property intended to be taken or which may be taken or in which a compulsory user and servitude may be acquired for the purposes thereof or of the Order together with a book of reference to such Plans containing the names of the owners or reputed owners lessees or reputed lessees and of the occupiers of the said lands and other property will be deposited for public inspection on or before the 30th day of November 1928 in the Office at Inverness of the Sheriff Clerk of the County of Inverness and in the Office at Inverness of the Sheriff Clerk of the Inverness District of the County of Inverness and on or before the same day a copy of so much of the said plans sections and book of reference as relates to the parishes hereinafter mentioned in or through which the intended works are proposed to be made or lands are situate will be deposited as follows (that is to say):—
