

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1929.

RECONSTITUTED COUNTY COUNCIL

FOR THE
COUNTY OF STIRLING.

In accordance with the requirements of subsection (4) of Section 8 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, intimation is hereby given that the Secretary of State proposes to make an Order in the terms annexed hereto, and that before making the said Order he will consider any objections and representations in writing respecting the same received in the Scottish Office, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, within twenty-one days of the date hereof.

ORDER by the Secretary of State determining the contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County of Stirling, the number of county councillors for the County and the apportionment of these county councillors between the landward area and the burghs entitled to be represented on the County Council.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 8 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, I hereby determine as follows:—

1. For the purposes of the reconstitution of the County Council of the County of Stirling (in this Order called the County) the number of county councillors for the County shall be 70.

2. The number of county councillors to be elected for the landward area of the County shall be 39.

3. The contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County shall be as follows:—

1	Buchanan	The parish of Buchanan.
2	Drymen	The parish of Drymen.
3	Balfroun	The parish of Balfroun.
4	Fintry and Killearn	(1) The parish of Fintry, and (2) the parish of Killearn.
5	Strathblane	The parish of Strathblane.
6	Baldernock	The parish of Baldernock.
7	Lennoxton	That part of the parish of Campsie which is included within the following boundary, viz., a line starting at the level crossing on the London and North Eastern Railway line at Rowantreefauld, and running thence first in a north-westerly direction along the centre of the said railway line to the point at which it crosses the Lennox mill-lade, and thence in a north-easterly direction straight to a point on the road from Fintry to Lennoxton 20 yards north of the northmost point of Geelong Place, thence due south-east till it intersects the road from Benclouch Mains to Lennoxton, thence direct to the junction of the road between Kilsyth and Lennoxton with the road between Kirkintilloch and Lennoxton by way of Kinkell, and thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the last-mentioned road to the starting point.
8	Milton	That part of the parish of Campsie which lies to the east of a line drawn in a southerly direction along the centre of the road leading from Fintry by Lennoxton and Kinkell to Kirkintilloch, from the point at which the said road enters, to the point at which it leaves, the parish, exclusive of the portion included within the Lennoxton division.
9	Torrance	The remainder of the parish of Campsie.
10	Kippen	The parish of Kippen.
11	Gargunnoch	The parish of Gargunnoch.
12	Logie	(1) The parish of Logie exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Bridge of Allan, and (2) the parish of Stirling exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Stirling and of that portion which lies to the west of the burgh of Stirling.
13	Bannockburn	That part of the Parish of St. Ninians which is included within the following boundary, namely,—A line commencing at a point on the Edinburgh Road 250 feet or thereby north-west of the Established Church Manse, thence proceeding in a straight line in a southerly direction to the south-west corner of the lands of Hillpark, thence along the south-western boundary of the said lands and continuing in the same direction till it reaches the River Bannock,
