

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1929.

RECONSTITUTED COUNTY COUNCIL
FOR THE
COUNTY OF KINCARDINE.

In accordance with the requirements of subsection (4) of Section 8 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, intimation is hereby given that the Secretary of State proposes to make an Order in the terms annexed hereto, and that before making the said Order he will consider any objections and representations in writing respecting the same received in the Scottish Office, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, within twenty-one days of the date hereof.

ORDER by the Secretary of State determining the contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County of Kincardine, the number of county councillors for the County and the apportionment of these county councillors between the landward area and the burghs entitled to be represented on the County Council.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 8 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, I hereby determine as follows:—

1. For the purposes of the reconstitution of the County Council of the County of Kincardine (in this Order called the County) the number of county councillors for the County shall be 33.

2. The number of county councillors to be elected for the landward area of the County shall be 22.

3. The contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County shall be as follows:—

1	Durris... ..	The parish of Durris.
2	Strachan	The parish of Strachan.
3	Banchory-Ternan North.	That part of the parish of Banchory-Ternan which lies to the north of the London and North Eastern Railway line exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Banchory.
4	Banchory-Ternan South.	The remainder of the parish of Banchory-Ternan exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Banchory.
5	Maryculter	The parish of Maryculter.
6	Banchory-Devenick.	The parish of Banchory-Devenick.
7	Nigg North	That part of the parish of Nigg which lies to the west and north of a line drawn in a generally north-easterly direction along the centre of the road leading from Redcroft by Charlestown and Redmoss to Aberdeen, from the point at which the said road enters the parish to the point at which it meets the north boundary of the estate of Loirston, thence to and along the north boundary of the said estate and the north boundary of the estate of Altens to the east-most point of the last-mentioned boundary, and thence due east to the sea.
8	Nigg South	The remainder of the parish of Nigg.
9	Cockney	That part of the parish of Fetteresso which is included within the limits of the <i>quoad sacra</i> parish of Cockney.
10	Fetteresso	The remainder of the parish of Fetteresso exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Stonehaven.
11	Dunnottar	The parish of Dunnottar exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Stonehaven.
12	Kinneff	The parish of Kinneff and Caterline exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Inverbervie.
13	Arbuthnott	The parish of Arbuthnott.
14	Glenbervie	The parish of Glenbervie.
15	Fordoun North ...	That part of the parish of Fordoun which lies to the east and north of a line drawn straight from the angle in the parish boundary at the top of the Goyle Hill in a south-easterly direction to the point where the road from Stonehaven to Fettercairn crosses the road from Powburn to Auchenblae near Fordoun House, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of the first-mentioned road to the point where it meets the Stonehaven and Laurencekirk
