	Garscadden— <i>contd.</i>	centre of Garscadden Road to the northern boundary of the London and North Eastern Railway (Glasgow, Dumbarton and Helensburgh line) and thence in a westerly direction along the said boundary to the western boundary of the parish.
26	New Kilpatrick South.	That part of the parish of New Kilpatrick so far as situated within the County of Dunbarton which is bounded on the north by the Garscadden Division and on the north east by a line drawn from the junction of Drumchapel Road with the road from Stirling to Glasgow by Drymen in a southerly direction along the centre of the last mentioned road to the boundary of the parish.
27	Millichen ... ..	That part of the parish of New Kilpatrick which is bounded on the west by the Garscadden and New Kilpatrick South Divisions and on the north by a line drawn from the junction of the road leading from Stirling to Glasgow by Drymen with the Roman Road in an easterly direction along the centre of the last mentioned road to the north western boundary of the London and North Eastern Railway (Milngavie Branch) thence in a north easterly direction along the said boundary to the point at which it meets Craigdow Burn and thence in a generally south easterly direction along the said Burn and the <i>medium filum</i> of the Allander Water to the eastern boundary of the parish.
28	New Kilpatrick East.	The remainder of the parish of New Kilpatrick so far as situated within the County of Dunbarton exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Milngavie.
29	Twechar ... ..	That part of the parish of Kirkintilloch exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Kirkintilloch which lies to the north of a line drawn along the centre of the road leading from Craiglenn in the parish of Cumbernauld to the burgh of Kirkintilloch by Drumgrew Bridge and Oxbang Bridge from the point at which the said road enters the parish of Kirkintilloch to the point at which it enters the said burgh and of a line drawn due west from the last mentioned point to the western boundary of the parish.
30	Waterside ... ..	The remainder of the parish of Kirkintilloch exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Kirkintilloch.
31	Condorrat ... ..	That part of the parish of Cumbernauld which lies to the west of a line drawn from the point at which the Dullatur and Cumbernauld Road crosses the parish boundary at Craigmarnoch in a generally south easterly direction along the centre of the said road to the northern boundary of enclosure No. 591 as delineated on the Ordnance Survey Sheet NXXXIX. 13 Edition 1916, thence in a westerly and south easterly direction along the northern and south western boundaries of the said enclosure and the south western boundaries of enclosures Nos. 590 and 589 as delineated on the said sheet to the south western corner of the last mentioned enclosure thence in a south easterly direction in a straight line across the road leading from Glasgow to Stirling by Cumbernauld to the north west corner of enclosure No. 625 as delineated on the said Sheet thence along the south western boundary of the last mentioned enclosure to the south west corner thereof thence in a southerly direction in a straight line through enclosure No. 656 as delineated in Ordnance Survey Sheet NXXXIX. 14 Edition 1916, and enclosures Nos. 649, 655, 654, 653, and 661 as delineated on the Ordnance Survey Sheet NXXXIV. 2 Edition 1916 to a point on the south eastern boundary of the last mentioned enclosure opposite the centre of the road No. 1129 as delineated on the last mentioned Sheet thence in a generally southerly direction along the centre of the said road to its junction with the road leading from Stirling to Carlisle and thence along the centre of the last mentioned road until it crosses the parish boundary at Luggie Bridge.
32	Cumbernauld ... ..	The remainder of the parish of Cumbernauld.
