4	Bo'ness and Carriden (2).	The remainder of the parish of Bo'ness and Carriden exclusive of the portion which is included within the limits of the burgh of Bo'ness.
5	Linlithgow East ...	That part of the parish of Linlithgow which lies to the east of a line drawn from the point on the parish boundary at which it is crossed by the road leading north from West Binny over Mains Burn past Ochiltree Mill and Wester Ochiltree in a northerly direction along the centre of the said road to the point at which it meets the Haugh Burn, thence in a north-westerly direction straight to the junction of the Edinburgh and Linlithgow road with the road leading to Philipstoun Station, thence along the centre of the last-mentioned road to its junction with the road leading past Kingsfield to Groughfoot, and thence along the centre of the said road to Groughfoot to the point at which it crosses the parish boundary.
6	Linlithgow West ...	The remainder of the parish of Linlithgow exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Linlithgow.
7	Ecclesmachan ...	(1) The parish of Ecclesmachan, and (2) that part of the parish of Kirkliston which lies to the west of a line drawn in a northerly direction along the centre of the Union Canal from the point at which it leaves the parish of Uphall to the point at which it enters the parish of Abercorn.
8	Kirkliston (1) ...	That part of the parish of Kirkliston which is bounded on the west by the Ecclesmachan Division and on the east and south by a line drawn from the point on the parish boundary at which it is crossed by the road leading from Westfield through Muiriehall Plantation along the centre of the said road in a southerly direction to its junction with the Linlithgow and Kirkliston road, thence along the centre of the last-mentioned road in an easterly direction to its junction with the road leading by Overton to Broomhouse, and thence along the centre of the said road to Broomhouse in a southerly and westerly direction to the centre of the Union Canal.
9	Kirkliston (2) ...	The remainder of the parish of Kirkliston so far as situated within the County of West-lothian.
10	Torphichen (1) ...	That part of the parish of Torphichen which lies to the east and north of a line drawn from the point at which the Avon Viaduct crosses the boundary of the parish along the centre of the Bathgate and Blackston Branch of the London and North Eastern Railway to the point at which it meets the road leading to Brighouse, thence in a southerly direction along the centre of the said road to its junction with the Gowansbank Road, and thence in an easterly direction along the last-mentioned road to the boundary of the parish.
11	Torphichen (2) ...	That part of the parish of Torphichen which lies to the west and south of the Torphichen (1) Division and to the east of a line drawn from the point on the parish boundary at which it is crossed by the road leading from Hardhill by Westcraigs Inn to Valley Plantation in a northerly direction along the centre of the said road to the point at which it meets the western boundary of the said plantation, and thence along the said western boundary to the point at which it meets the boundary of the parish.
12	Torphichen (3) ...	The remainder of the parish of Torphichen.
13	Livingston (1) ...	That part of the parish of Livingston which lies to the north of a straight line drawn from the point at which the Lochshot Burn meets the western boundary of the parish to a point on the eastern boundary of the parish opposite the west entrance to Howden House.
14	Livingston (2) ...	That part of the parish of Livingston which is bounded on the north by the Livingston (1) Division, on the south and east by the <i>medium filum</i> of the river Almond and on the west by a line drawn from the point at which the Westwood Road crosses the boundary of the parish at the river Almond in a northerly direction along the centre
