The remainder of the parish of Sandsting and Aithsting:
14	Sandness	That part of the parish of Walls and Sandness which lies to the north of a line drawn from the point on the boundary between the parishes of Walls and Sandness and Sandsting and Aithsting which is nearest to Daney's Loch straight to the point at which the Burn of Cottikismires enters Burga Water thence up the said burn and through the centre of the lochs of East and West Dalsa Water to the Burn of Dale, thence down the last mentioned burn to the Voe of Dale, and thence along the centre of the said Voe to its mouth, including the island of Papa Stour.
15	Walls	The remainder of the parish of Walls and Sandness, including the island of Foula.
16	Whiteness and Weis- dale.	That part of the parish of Tingwall which lies to the north and west of a line drawn up the centre of Whiteness Voe to a point opposite the head of Brei Geo, thence due east by the said head to the most easterly point of Maggie
17 18 19	Tingwall Bressay Burra and Quarff	Black's Loch, thence in a northerly easterly direction straight to the point known as The Spoiled Wife's House near Vatster, and thence in a northerly direction straight to the point on the boundary between the parishes of Tingwall and Nesting which is nearest to the Loch of Sand Water. The remainder of the parish of Tingwall. The parish of Bressay. That part of the parish of Lerwick which lies to the west and south of a line drawn from the head of the East Voe of Quarff straight to the nearest point on the boun- dary between the parishes of Lerwick and Tingwall. including the islands of East and West Barra and South Havera.
20	Gulberwick	The remainder of the parish of Lerwick exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Lerwick.
21	Cunningsburgh	That part of the parish of Dunrossness which lies to the north of a line drawn in a westerly direction straight from the head of Mokies Geo to the nearest point of Stouri Croo.
22	Sandwick	That part of the parish of Dunrossness which lies to the south of the Cunningsburgh Division and to the north of a line drawn from the head of Brei Geo to the nearest point on the summit of the Mossy Hill, thence along the summit of the said hill to the source of the Burn of Sevdale, and thence down the said burn to the sea to the head of Ireland Wick.
23	Dunrossness North.	That part of the parish of Dunrossness which lies to the south of the Sandwick Division and to the north of the bay of Voe and of a line drawn from the mouth of the burn which enters the said bay at its head, up the said burn till it reaches the public road from Lerwick to Sumburgh, thence straight to the nearest point of the loch of Brow, thence through the said loch to the burn which forms its outlet and down the last mentioned burn to the point at which it enters the loch of Spiggie, and thence due west to the sea.
24	Dunrossness South.	The remainder of the parish of Dunrossness, including Fair Isle.

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
