41	Portree East... ..	The remainder of the parish of Portree.
42	Bracadale	The parish of Bracadale.
43	Duirinish West	That part of the parish of Duirinish which lies to the south and west of Loch Dunvegan and of a line drawn from a point at the head of the said loch southwest of the point of junction at Dunvegan Hotel of the road from Hornival to Dunvegan with the road from Bracadale to Dunvegan to the said junction, and thence in a south-easterly direction along the centre of the last mentioned road to the boundary of the parish.
44	Duirinish East	The remainder of the parish of Duirinish.
45	Snizort	The parish of Snizort.
46	Kilmuir	The parish of Kilmuir.
47	North Uist (South).	That part of the parish of North Uist which lies to the south of a line drawn from the sea up the burn flowing into it at Dusary Mill till the said burn is crossed by the public road, thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of the road to Sollas (commonly called the Committee road) to the point of highest level thereon, thence in an easterly direction direct to the summit of Marrival Hill, thence direct to the point of junction of the road from Sponish with the north road from Lochmaddy, thence direct to the nearest point of the salt water of Loch Maddy, and thence through Loch Maddy to the open sea.
48	North Uist (North).	The remainder of the parish of North Uist.
49	Harris North	That part of the parish of Harris which is included within the limits of the Registration District of North Harris as defined by Interlocutor of the Sheriff of Inverness-shire of date 29th November 1877.
50	Harris South	The remainder of the parish of Harris, including the Island of Saint Kilda.
51	Benbecula	That part of the parish of South Uist which consists of the island of Benbecula and of the small islands lying to the north and east of Bagh nam Faoileann and of South Uist ford.
52	South Uist	That part of the parish of South Uist which lies to the south of the Benbecula division and to the north of a line drawn in a generally north-westerly direction from the open sea at the mouth of Loch Eynort through the said loch, through the stream flowing into it from Loch Ollay, and through the last mentioned loch to its westmost point, and thence due west to the sea.
53	Lochboisdale... ..	The remainder of the parish of South Uist.
54	Barra	The parish of Barra.

This Order shall come into force on the first day of October 1929, and the Order of the Secretary for Scotland dated the 27th August 1889, determining the number of County Councillors for each County Council in Scotland and apportioning them between the county and each of the burghs entitled to be represented on the County Council, so far as relating to the County of Inverness, and the Order of the Boundary Commissioners under the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, dated the 1st February 1892, relating to the County of Inverness, together with any Orders amending the same, are hereby repealed as from 16th May 1930.
