

3. The contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County shall be as follows:—

1	Alloa First	That part of the parish of Alloa which is bounded on the east by a line drawn from the point in the river Forth at which the southern boundary of the parish meets the boundary of the burgh of Alloa in a westerly and north-easterly direction along the last mentioned boundary to the point at which it meets the road leading from Alloa to Tullibody, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of the said road to a point opposite the eastern side of Kennel Cottage, and thence in a northerly direction passing immediately to the east of the said Cottage and of Muirpark Farm straight to the northern boundary of the parish.
2	Alloa Second	That part of the parish of Alloa which is included within the following boundary, viz.:—A line drawn from the point at which the southern boundary of the parish meets the eastern boundary of the burgh of Alloa in a generally northerly direction along the last mentioned boundary to the cross roads at the Whins, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Carsebridge Road to a point opposite the centre of Hilton Cottages, thence in a north-westerly direction straight to a point on the mineral railway leading to Jellyholm Pit opposite the eastern boundary of Tibby Ramsay's Sink, thence in a westerly direction along the said railway for a distance of 400 yards or thereby to the point at which it meets Holton Row, thence along the centre of Holton Row to the point at which it meets the London and North Eastern Railway line at the end of Mar Place, Sauchie, thence along the last mentioned railway in a north-easterly direction to the point at which it meets the parish boundary and thence along the eastern and southern boundaries of the parish to the point of commencement.
3	Alloa Third	The remainder of the parish of Alloa exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Alloa.
4	Clackmannan First.	That part of the parish of Clackmannan which is included within the following boundary, viz.:—A line commencing at the point at which the stream called the Black Devon is crossed by Mary Bridge and drawn in an easterly direction up the said stream to the point at which the Goudnie Burn falls into it, thence in a south-easterly direction up the Goudnie Burn to the point near Filmuir at which it is crossed by the road leading to Tulligarth farm, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the said road till it joins the main road from Clackmannan to Kennet thence in a south-easterly direction along the centre of the last mentioned road to a point opposite the Blue House Lodge gate, thence in a south-westerly direction straight to a point in the centre of the road from Clackmannan to Kennetpans due west of the Chapel Well, thence in a north-westerly direction straight to Clackmannan Tower, and from Clackmannan Tower in a northerly direction straight to the starting point.
5	Clackmannan Second.	The remainder of the parish of Clackmannan.
6	Alva	The parish of Alva exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Alva.
7	Tillicoultry	The parish of Tillicoultry exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Tillicoultry.
8	Dollar	The parish of Dollar exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Dollar.
