Whereas We have deemed it expedient that a Commission should forthwith issue to

enquire into the provisions and working of the Unemployment Insurance Scheme, and to make recommendations with regard to:—

- (1) its future scope, the provisions which it should contain and the means by which it may be made solvent and self-supporting, and
- (2) the arrangement which should be made outside the Scheme for the unemployed who are capable of and available for work:

Now know ye that We, reposing great trust and confidence in your knowledge and ability, have authorised and appointed, and do by these Presents authorise and appoint you the said Henry Holman Gregory (Chairman); William Asbury; Henry Clay; Hector James Wright Hetherington; Edward Charles Ponsonby Lascelles; Clara Dorothea Rackham and Harold Moltke Trouncer to be Our Commissioners for the purposes of the said enquiry:

And for the better effecting the purposes of this Our Commission, We do by these Presents give and grant unto you, or any three or more of you, full power to call before you such persons as you shall judge likely to afford you any information upon the subject of this Our Commission; to call for information in writing; and also to call for, have access to, and examine all such books, documents, registers and records as may afford you the fullest information on the subject, and to

enquire of and concerning the premises by all other lawful ways and means whatsoever:

And We do by these Presents authorise and empower you, or any of you, to visit and inspect personally such places as you may deem it expedient so to inspect for the more effectual carrying out of the purposes afore-

And We do by these Presents will and ordain that this Our Commission shall continue in full force and virtue, and that you, Our said Commissioners, or any three or more of you, may from time to time proceed in the execution thereof, and of every matter and thing therein contained, although the same be not continued from time to time by adjourn-

And We do further ordain that you, or any three or more of you, have liberty to report your proceedings under this Our Commission from time to time if you shall judge it expedient so to do:

And Our further will and pleasure is that you do, with as little delay as possible, report to Us under your hands and seals, or under the hands and seals of any three or more of you, your opinion upon the matters herein submitted for your consideration.
