THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DUNDEE CITY WARDS) ORDER (SCOTLAND), 1932, DATED 8TH OCTOBER 1932, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1929 (19 AND 20 GEO. 5, c. 25).

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Secretary of State by the Corporation of the City of Dundee (hereinafter referred to as the City) that he should make an Order under Section 36 (1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, altering the boundaries of Ward Third and Ward Eighth of the City:

And whereas it is expedient to give effect to the said representation:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 36 (1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, hereby orders as follows:—

1. The boundaries of Ward Third and Ward Eighth of the City shall respectively be the boundaries as set forth in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Dundee City Wards) Order (Scotland), 1932.

WARD THIRD.

Commencing at the junction of Johnston Avenue and Clepington Road and proceeding thence along Johnston Avenue to Strathmore Avenue, thence westward along Strathmore Avenue, thence southward along Alpin Road, thence westward along Loons Road, thence southward along Lawside Road to Law Steps, thence westward along Law Steps to Lochee Road, thence southward along Lochee Road to its junction with Tullideph Road, thence westward along Tullideph Road to City Road, thence northward along City Road and Logie Street to Ancrum Road, thence westward along Ancrum Road to Farm Road leading to the Farm of Backhill of Balgay, thence westward along Farm Road to Burgh Boundary, thence northwards following the boundary of the Burgh as extended to the south west corner of property known as Bracken Bruach, thence
