

COUNTY OF EAST LOTHIAN.

NOTIFICATION is hereby given, in terms of Section 14 (2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1908, that at a Special Meeting, held on 11th December 1933, the County Council of the County of East Lothian passed Resolutions:—

- (First) Enlarging Pencaitland Special Lighting and Scavenging Districts by including therein the County Council Housing Scheme (No. 4 development) garden ground to the north east of Deanwood, Pencaitland, part of the school playground and ground to the west thereof, all as delineated and shown hatched red on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Second) Enlarging Ormiston Special Drainage, Lighting, and Scavenging Districts by including therein the County Council Housing Schemes (Nos. 5 and 6 developments) all as delineated and shown hatched red on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.

- (Fifth) Enlarging Stenton Special Lighting District by including therein the County Council Housing Scheme (No. 1 development) ground to east and west thereof and garage and grounds opposite and lying to the southeast thereof the Bowling Green, garden ground to the southwest thereof the Village Hall and the whole field in which the said hall is situated all as delineated and coloured green on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Sixth) Enlarging Athelstaneford Special Drainage District by including therein the County Council Housing Scheme (No. 2 development) all as delineated and shown within the outer edge of the blue lines on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Seventh) Enlarging Dirlerton Special Scavenging and Lighting Districts by including therein feuing ground situated at the northwest corner of the existing Special Districts all as delineated and shown within the outer edge of the blue lines on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Eighth) Enlarging Dirlerton Special Drainage, Lighting, and Scavenging Districts by including therein the County Council Housing Scheme (No. 4 development) and the dwelling-house to the east thereof all as delineated and shown within the outer edge of the yellow lines on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Ninth) Enlarging Garvald Special Drainage District by including therein the County Council Housing Scheme (No. 1 development) and ground to the south thereof between the public road and the Papan Water all as delineated and shown within the outer edge of the yellow lines on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Tenth) Enlarging Dirlerton (East) Special Lighting District by including therein feuing ground to the east of Strathern Road, North Berwick, all as delineated and shown within the inner edge of the blue lines on Ordnance Map or Plan docquetted and subscribed as relative to the Resolution.
- (Eleventh) Adopting (a) for the purposes of the Lighting within the before-mentioned Special Lighting Districts as so enlarged the provisions contained in Sections 99 to 105, in-

clusive, of the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act, 1892, and (b) for the purposes of the Scavenging, &c., within the before-mentioned Special Scavenging Districts as so enlarged the provisions contained in Sections 107 to 127 and 253 to 255, inclusive, of the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act, 1892, and Section 24 of the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act, 1903.
