NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE A SPECIAL ORDER VARYING AND AMENDING THE SPECIAL SCHEME OF UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE FOR THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY.

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he proposes, by virtue of the powers conferred upon him by Section 18 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, and all powers in that behalf, to make a Special Order further varying and amending the Insurance Industry Special Scheme.

Copies of the draft Special Order may be obtained on application in writing to the Assistant Secretary, Ministry of Labour, Unemployment Insurance Department, Montagu House, Whitehall, London, S.W.1.

Objections to the draft Special Order must be sent to the above address within 21 days from the eleventh day of January 1935.

Every objection must be in writing and must state:—

- (a) the draft Order or portions of the draft Order objected to;
- (b) the specific grounds of objection;
- (c) the omissions, additions, or modifications asked for.

THE SALE OF FOOD (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1935, DATED 2ND JANUARY 1935, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER THE MINISTRY OF FOOD (CONTINUANCE) ACT, 1920 (10 & 11 GEO. 5, c. 47), THE MINISTRY OF FOOD (CESSATION) ORDER, 1921 (S.R. & O. 1921, No. 445), AND THE EXPIRING LAWS CONTINUANCE ACT, 1934 (24 & 25 GEO. 5, c. 57).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Ministry of Food (Continuance) Act, 1920, the Ministry of Food (Cessation) Order, 1921, (a) the Expiring Laws Continu-

ance Act, 1934, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, the Board of Trade hereby order as follows:—

1. The Sale of Food Order, 1921, (b) is hereby revoked.

2. (a) This Order may be cited as the Sale of Food (Revocation) Order, 1935, and shall come into force on the 7th January 1935.

(b) The Interpretation Act, 1889 (52 & 53 V. c. 63), applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

THE GAS FUND (CONTRIBUTION) ORDER, 1935, DATED JANUARY 2, 1935, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920 (10 & 11 GEO. 5, c. 28) AS AMENDED BY THE GAS UNDERTAKINGS ACT, 1934 (24 & 25 GEO. 5, c. 28).

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 7 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, as amended by the Gas Undertakings Act, 1934, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, the Board of Trade hereby prescribe as follows:—

1. The rate of contribution to the Gas Fund for the year 1935 shall be:—

(a) one shilling and one penny for each five thousand therms in the form of gas sold during the year 1934 (excluding gas sold to other undertakers in bulk for distribution and gas supplied separately for industrial purposes only); and

(b) six and one half pence for each five thousand therms in the form of gas supplied separately for industrial purposes only during the year 1934.

2. Such contribution shall be paid on or before the 1st April 1935 to the Board of Trade at Great George Street, London, S.W.1, by all Gas Undertakers with respect to whom an Order under the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, shall have been made or to whom sub-section (3) of Section 7 of that Act applies by virtue of any public general Act, Special Act, or Special Order.

3. Payment of the contribution shall be by cheque made payable to the "Board of Trade" and crossed "Bank of England."

4. This Order may be cited as the Gas Fund (Contribution) Order, 1935.
