The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two-day shifts of women of 18 and young persons of 16 years of age and over in machine core-making at the Kirkland Works of National Steel Foundry (1914) Limited, Leven, Fife, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable cloakroom and messroom accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided.

#### DENHOLM SPECIAL DRAINAGE, WATER, AND LIGHTING DISTRICTS.
