## WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1925. INDUSTRIAL DISEASES.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that on the 8th April 1935 he made an Order under Section 43 of the above Act, amending the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation (Industrial Diseases) Consolidation Order, 1929, relating to X-rays Disease.

The Order may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Industrial Diseases) Order,
