REGULATIONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ASSIST-ANT TECHNICAL OFFICERS FOR FURNITURE IN H.M. OFFICE OF WORKS.

N.B.—Competitions under these regulations are open both to men and women. Competitions do not take place at fixed intervals, but are held as occasion arises on the occurrence of vacancies. The regulations are liable to alteration from time to time.

1. Candidates must have attained the age of 25 on a date to be fixed in respect of the competition in which they are to take part, but must not have attained 35 years of age on that date.

Candidates who have served or are serving in the Navy, Army, or Air Force may deduct from their actual age for this purpose any
