NATIONAL SAVINGS CERTIFICATES.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon Them by Section 5 of the War Loan (Supplemental Provisions) Act, 1915, as amended by Section 2 of the War Loan Act, 1918, Section 33 of the Finance Act, 1923, and Section 23 of the Finance Act, 1932, and of all other powers enabling Them in that behalf, to make the Savings Certificates (Amendment) Regulations, 1937.

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS.

1. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Bill Office, at the Bank of England, on Friday the 16th July 1937, at 1 o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the War Loan Acts, 1914-1919, to the amount of £35,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5000 or £10,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday the 19th July 1937 to Saturday the 24th July 1937 inclusive, and will be payable at three months after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000, and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being an even multiple of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House, or Broker.

6. The persons whose Tenders are accepted will be informed of the same not later than the following day, and payment in full of the amounts of the accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of Cash or a Banker's Draft on the Bank of England not later than 2 o'clock (Saturday 12 o'clock) on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

7. In virtue of the provisions of Section 1 (4) of the War Loan Act, 1919, Members of the

House of Commons are not precluded from tendering for these Bills.

8. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.

9. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

KIRKINTILLOCH GAS.

(APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL ORDER UNDER THE GAS UNDERTAKINGS ACTS 1920 TO 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade forthwith by the Provost Magistrates and Councillors of the Burgh of Kirkintilloch (hereinafter referred to as "the Town Council") whose address is Council Chambers Kirkintilloch for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934 for all or some of the following (amongst other) purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the existing limits of gas supply of the Town Council and to authorise them to supply gas within that part of the Parish of Campsie in the County of Stirling within which the Town Council are not presently supplying gas (hereinafter referred to as "the added limits").

To transfer to and vest in the Town Council the undertaking of the Lennoxton Gas Light Company (constituted by Contract of Copartnership and hereinafter referred to as "the Lennoxton Company") including certain lands forming part of that undertaking and the gasworks of the Lennoxton Company situate thereon and all property and assets powers rights and privileges of the Lennoxton Company upon and subject to such terms and conditions and subject to such provisions with regard to the liabilities and obligations of the Lennoxton Company as have been agreed between the Town Council and the Lennoxton Company or as may be prescribed by the Order and to prescribe the date on which such transfer and vesting shall take effect.
