NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Department of Health for Scotland, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (2) of section 154 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Unclaimed Proceeds of Stamp Sales) Regulations, 1938.
