FACTORIES ACT, 1937.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that on the 13th December 1938 he made Regulations under the Factories Act, 1937, modifying the provisions of Section 73 of the Act, as to overtime, to meet seasonal or other pressure of work.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 134 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Reserve Forces) Regulations, 1938; And that, on account of urgency, the

National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Reserve Forces) Regulations, 1938, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act;
