COLONIAL STOCK ACTS, 1877 TO 1934.

Addition to List of Stocks under Section 2 OF THE COLONIAL STOCK ACT, 1900 (63 AND 64 Vic., CAP. 62).

Pursuant to Section 2 of the Colonial Stock Act, 1900, the Lords Commissioners of H.M. Treasury hereby give notice that the provisions of the Act have been complied with in respect

of the undermentioned stock registered or inscribed in the United Kingdom:

PETROLEUM (CONSOLIDATION) ACT, 1928.
