ROYAL AIR FORCE.

AIR FORCE ACT.

It is proposed to amend the Rules of Procedure (Air Force), 1933, made under section 70 of the Air Force Act.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Health, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment Regulations, 1942; and that, on account of urgency, the Minister of Health, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated June 22, 1942, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment Regulations, 1942, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)
ACT, 1940.
