## THE SHORT BROTHERS (ROCHESTER & BEDFORD) LIMITED (TRANSFER OF SHARES) ORDER, 1943, MADE UNDER REGULATION 78 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

Whereas by the Short Brothers (Rochester & Bedford) Limited Control Order, 1943, the Minister of Aircraft Production (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") authorised an authorised controller to exercise functions of control on behalf of His Majesty with respect of the undertaking carried on by the Company called Short Brothers (Rochester & Bedford) Limited:
