SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

COUNTY OF EAST LOTHIAN.

Under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, the Secretary of State made on 19th May 1942 an Order which provided for an extension by three years of the time within which the County Council of the County of East Lothian (hereinafter referred to as "the Local Authority") may exercise the powers of compulsory purchase conferred upon them by the undermentioned Compulsory Purchase Order. A subsequent Order under the said Act has been made by the Secretary of State, the effect of which is to extend by two more years the time within which the Local Authority may exercise the said compulsory powers.

The Compulsory Purchase Order referred to is as follows :—

NURSES ACT, 1943.

Use of the word "nurse."

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Health, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso (b) to subsection (1) of section 6 of the Nurses Act, 1943, to make regulations entitled the Nurses Regulations, 1945, for authorising the use of specified names or titles containing the word nurse or of the word nurse otherwise qualified in accordance with the said regulations.
