

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of National Insurance, and the Minister of Health, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 102 and 118 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations, 1946.

On account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of National Insurance, and the Minister of Health, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated December 17, 1945, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations (No. 2), 1945, to come into operation forthwith a provisional rules and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

THE CORPORATION OF GLASGOW.
ONE WAY TRAFFIC IN STREETS.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Corporation of the City of Glasgow, in virtue of the powers conferred on them by Section 38 (1) of the Glasgow Corporation Order, 1929, have made the following Regulation and, in terms of Sub-Section 3 (a) of the said Section, have submitted the same to the Minister of War Transport for his approval, viz. :—

CITY AND ROYAL BURGH OF GLASGOW.
REGULATION AS TO ONE-WAY TRAFFIC IN STREETS.

The Corporation of the City of Glasgow, in virtue of the powers conferred on them by Section 38 of the Glasgow Cor-

poration Order, 1929, under which they may from time to time make regulations prescribing the streets in which traffic by vehicles shall pass in one specified direction only, either generally or during specified hours, have resolved to make, and do hereby make, the following Regulation for the purpose aforesaid, viz. :—

No person shall at any time drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the streets specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such streets in the second column of the said Schedule.
