The Minute referred to in the said Order is in the following terms:—

"THE NEW ZEALAND AND AUSTRALIAN LAND COMPANY LIMITED.

"The Capital of the New Zealand and Australian Land Company Limited was, by virtue of a Special Resolution and with the sanction of the Court dated 14th February 1947, reduced from £3,000,000, divided into £1,000,000 4 per cent Cumulative Preference Stock and £2,000,000 Ordinary Stock to £2,500,000, divided into £500,000 4 per cent Cumulative Preference Stock and £2,000,000 Ordinary Stock.
