DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of Section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Order :—

Statutory Instruments 1951, No. 1086.

The Sheep Scab (Amendment) Order, 1951.
(Made 22nd June 1951.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st July 1951, allows sheep to be moved without a licence from a collecting centre within an area declared to be a Movement Area for the purposes of the Sheep Scab Order of 1938 to a slaughterhouse outside such an area, provided that the movement takes place under the supervision of an official of the Ministry of Food.

NOTE.—The above statement is based on returns received from 108 prescribed towns in England and Wales in the week ended 23rd June 1951. The prices represent the average for all sales at these towns, which include transactions between growers and merchants, and some transactions between merchants, during the week ended 16th June 1951.
