THE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 7) WARRANT 1952.

Her Majesty's Postmaster-General hereby gives notice that, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 2, 12, and 82 of the Post Office Act, 1908, a Warrant dated the 17th day of March 1952 and coming into operation on the 31st day of March 1952, has been made on his representation by the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury. The Warrant increases the rates of postage on inland parcels and parcels posted in the British Islands for transmission to the Republic of Ireland, except the rates of postage on parcels not exceeding 2 lb. in weight which are unchanged.

And the Postmaster-General further gives notice that the said Warrant has been published as S.I. 1952, No. 557, and copies may be purchased directly from Her Majesty's
