The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926, entitled the Safeguarding of Industries (Exemption) (No.2) Order, 1956, which continues until 18th August, 1956, with certain additions and deletions, the exemption from Key Industry Duty of articles exempted from that duty by previous Orders which expire on the 18th February, 1956.

The Order comes into operation on the 19th February, 1956, and has been published as Statutory Instruments, 1956 No. 169.
