46. *Family Allowances.*

As from 1st February, 1948, the conditions governing a grant of family allowance in respect of a legally adopted child or step-child laid down in Clause 2 of Schedule A to this Order, shall also be applicable to the legally adopted children or step-children of a disabled officer.

"7. *Allowances for Unemployable Officers.*

(A) As from 18th August, 1948, the following Clause to be substituted for Clause 3 of Schedule C to Order in Council of 29th November, 1946:—

3. *Allowances for Unemployable Officers.*

Where an officer is receiving disability retired pay in respect of a disablement so serious as to make him unemployable he may be granted

(a) an allowance by way of supplement at the rate
