SCHEDULE

The effect of the proposed Order is to prohibit waiting on the undernoted length of road between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m., but nothing in the proposal shall prevent any person from boarding or alighting from the vehicle, enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded, to enable the vehicle from being used in connection with any building operation, demolition, removal or obstruction of traffic, maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, laying, erection or alteration or repair of services.

Length of Road
