## HIGH STREET AND BRIDGE PLACE, GALASHIELS WAITING RESTRICTIONS

THE Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under Section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is set out in the Schedule hereto.

### SCHEDULE

The Order revokes the existing Byelaws imposing unilateral waiting on High Street, Galashiels, between its junctions with Bridge Place and Sime Place and re-enacts these restrictions on High Street from a point 19 yards or thereby on the south side and 15 yards or thereby on the north side from its junction with Bridge Place to its junction with Sime Place and imposes no waiting on Bridge Place for a distance of 15 yards from its junction with High Street and on High Street from its junction with Bridge Place for a distance of 19 yards or thereby on the south side and 15 yards or thereby on the north side. No provision is made in the Order for waiting except upon the direction or with the permission of the police.

### RATES OF INTEREST ON LOCAL LOANS NOTICE

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Loans Act, 1897 (60 and 61 Vict. c. 51), the Public Works Loans Act, 1935 (26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8 c. 5) and the Local Authorities Loans Act, 1945 (8 & 9 Geo. 6 c. 18), they have directed by their Minute of 13th September 1962 that on loans advanced to local authorities from the Local Loans Fund, on and after 15th September 1962, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of the 14th August 1962 the following rates of interest:

Loans for not more than five years	6½
Loans for more than five years but not more than fifteen years	6½
Loans for more than fifteen years but not more than thirty year	6½
Loans for more than thirty years	6½
