3. In column 2 of Table in Article 11 of the 1920 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of pension which may be awarded to widows of ratings) for the figures 81s., 80s., 79s., 78s., 77s. and 76s. there shall be substituted the figures 95s., 94s., 93., 92s., 91s. and 90s. respectively.

4. In Article 12 of the 1920 Order as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for the children or ratings' widows) for the figures 29s., wherever the same appear, there shall be substituted the figures 34s.

5. In Article 18 (1) of the 1920 Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of pensions to certain ratings' children who have attained the age of 18 years and are incapable of self-support) for the figures 57s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures 67s. 6d.

6. For Schedule 1 to the 1920 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the assessments of disablement caused by specified injuries and of certain other disablements and the pensions which may be granted to ratings for such injuries and disablements) there shall be substituted Schedule 1 to this Order.

7. In Article 7 of the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for constant attendance on disabled officers) for the figures £104 and 80s. there shall be substituted the figures £130 and 100s. respectively.

8. In Article 12 (1) of the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances to widows of officers in respect of children) for the figures £83 10s. there shall be substituted the figures £96 10s.

9. In Article 17 of the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of pensions to certain officers' children who have attained the age of 18 years and are incapable of self-support) for the figures £149 10s. there shall be substituted the figures £175 10s.

10. In Article 27 of the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for constant attendance on disabled nurses) for the figures 80s. there shall be substituted the figures 100.

11. For Part I of Schedule 1 to the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of retired pay for disabled officers) there shall be substituted Schedule 2 to this Order.

12. For the figures in columns (2) to (5) in Schedule 2 to the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of pension for officers' widows) there shall be substituted the figures in the following columns:

13. For Schedule 3 to the 1921 (Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of pension for disabled nurses) there shall be substituted Schedule 3 to this Order.

14. In Article 7 of the 1921 (Warrant Officers) Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for constant attendance on disabled officers) for the figures 80s. there shall be substituted the figures 100s.

15. In Article 12 (1) of the 1921 (Warrant Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances to widows of officers in respect of children) for the figures £77 10s. there shall be substituted the figures £90 10s.

16. In Article 17 of the 1921 (Warrant Officers) Order, as amended (Orders of 29th September 1949 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of pensions to certain officers' children who have attained the age of 18

years and are incapable of self-support) for the figures £149 10s. there shall be substituted the figures £175 10s.

17. For Schedule 1 to 1921 (Warrant Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of retired pay for disabled officers) there shall be substituted Schedule 4 to this Order.

18. In column (2) of the Table in Schedule 3 to the 1921 (Warrant Officers) Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of pension for widows of officers) for the figures £258 and £233 there shall be substituted the figures £295 and £270 respectively.

19. In Article 5 of the 1949 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the supplementation of retired pay or pension and the award of allowances for unemployable pensioners):

(a) in paragraph (2), for the figures £164 and 63s. there shall be substituted the figures £193 and 74s. respectively;

(b) in paragraph (3) (b), for the figures £55 and 25s. there shall be substituted the figures £72 and 31s. 6d. respectively;

(c) in paragraph (3) (c), for the figures £91 and 35s. there shall be substituted the figures £108 and 41s. 6d. respectively;

(d) in paragraph (3) (e), for the words and figures "£45 10s. a year" there shall be substituted the words and figures "£52 a year and in respect of each other of those children to £31 6s. a year" and for the figures 17s. 6d. and 9s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures 20s. and 12s. respectively.

20. In Article 6 of the 1949 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for lowered standard of occupation) for the figures 39s. there shall be substituted the figures 46s.

21. In Article 7 of the 1949 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of personal and additional allowances for disabled officers and nurses during periods of approved treatment):

(a) in paragraph (1), for the figures 57s. 6d., wherever the same appear, there shall be substituted the figures 67s. 6d.;

(b) in paragraph (4), for the figures £55 and £91 there shall be substituted the figures £72 and £108 respectively, and for the proviso to sub-paragraph (b) there shall be substituted the following proviso:

"Provided that the rate of the allowance for the first child may be increased to £52 a year and for each other child to £31 6s. a year;"

22. In Article 8 of the 1949 Order, as amended (Orders of 18th July 1952 and 21st December 1960), (which provides for the award of allowances for disabled ratings receiving approved treatment):

(a) in paragraph (2), for the figures 97s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures 115s.;

(b) in paragraph (3), for the figures 57s. 6d., wherever the same appear, there shall be substituted the figures 67s. 6d.;

(c) in paragraph (4), for the figures 25s., 17s. 6d., 9s. 6d. and 35s. there shall be substituted the figures 31s. 6d., 20s., 12s. and 41s. 6d. respectively, and in the proviso to sub-paragraph (b) the words "where an allowance is awarded under paragraph (3) of this Article," shall be omitted;

(d) in paragraph (7), for the figures 114s. 2d., 107s. 6d., 104s. 2d., 100s. 10d. and 97s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures 131s. 8d., 125s., 121s. 8d., 118s. 4d. and 115s. respectively.

In Article 13 (1) of the 1949 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which sets out the rates of pension which may be awarded to ratings for 100 per cent. disablement) for the figures 114s. 2d., 107s. 6d., 104s. 2d., 100s. 10d. and 97s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures 131s. 8d., 125s., 121s. 8d., 118s. 4d. and 115s. respectively.

24. In Article 14 of the 1949 Order, as amended (Order of 21st December 1960), (which provides for awards to widows and children on the death of officers or ratings on or after the 3rd September 1939):

(a) in paragraph (c) of the proviso to paragraph (2), for the figures £128 10s., £100, £120 10s., 34s. 6d. and 46s. there shall be substituted the figures £149 10s., £116, £141 10s., 40s. 6d. and 54s. respectively.

(b) in paragraph (3), for the figures £149 10s. and 57s. 6d. there shall be substituted the figures £175 10s. and 67s. 6d. respectively.
