This Order implements part of the recent Protocol to the Anglo-Danish agreement on agriculture by removing the E.F.T.A. rate (and, by virtue of the United Kingdom's obligations under the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, the full rate) of import duty on butter.

The Order comes into operation on the 10th July 1963, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1963, No. 1170.
