

THE MORAY AND NAIRN (LOSSIEMOUTH AIRFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1963

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait (i) to permit a person to board or alight therefrom; (ii) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded therefrom or (iii) in connection with the maintenance of the road or of the services of any public undertaken therein.
