WAITING RESTRICTIONS—TRUNK ROADS  
A.85 AND A.816 IN OBAN

THE Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 the effect of which is set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The Order revokes the Trunk Roads (George Street, Oban) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1958 and prohibits waiting and imposes unilateral waiting restrictions on the fixed day system, between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on lengths of the Tarbert-Inveraray-Lochalphead-Oban Trunk Road (Route A.816) and the Tyndrum-Oban Trunk Road (Route A.85) in Oban in the County of Argyll as follows:

1. PROHIBITION OF WAITING

*Trunk Road A.816—*

- between points 50 yards south and 16 yards north of its junction with Miller Road;
- between points 10 yards south and 65 yards north of its junction with Glencruitten Road;
- between a point 11 yards south of its junction with Stevenson Street and its junction with High Street.

*Trunk Road A.85—*

- between the south side of its junction with Airds Crescent and a point 20 yards north of its junction with Stevenson Street;
- between points 39 yards south and 7 yards north of its junction with Stafford Street;
- between points 18 yards south and 121 yards north of its junction with Nursery Lane.

2. UNILATERAL WAITING

*Trunk Road A.816—*

- between points 155 yards and 50 yards south of its junction with Miller Road;
- between points 16 yards north of its junction with Miller Road and 10 yards south of its junction with Glencruitten Road;
- between points 65 yards north of its junction with Glencruitten Road and 11 yards south of its junction with Stevenson Street.

*Trunk Road A.85—*

- between its junction with Argyll Square and the south side of its junction with Airds Crescent;
- between points 20 yards north of its junction with Stevenson Street and 39 yards south of its junction with Stafford Street;
- between points 7 yards north of its junction with Stafford Street and 18 yards south of its junction with Nursery Lane;
- between points 83 yards north of its junction with Breadalbane Street and 40 yards south of its junction with Corran Parks.

In the case of the unilateral lengths waiting is limited to 30 mins. in any hour on that side of the road on which vehicles are not prohibited from waiting for the time being. The Order provides for exceptions to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded and to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with building operations or demolitions, etc.

*Amendment to County of Stirling Development Plan*

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that proposals for amendment to the above Development Plan (hereinafter referred to as "the proposals") were submitted to the Secretary of State for Scotland on the Twenty-fifth day of June Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-four.

The proposals relate to zoning for residential purposes an area of 9.0 acres and an area of 5.0 acres for a Primary School at South Broomage, Larbert, previously zoned for agricultural purposes.

A Certified Copy of the proposals as submitted has been deposited for inspection by the public at the office of the County Planning Department, 18 Melville Terrace, Stirling.

A Certified Copy of the proposals has also been deposited for inspection by the public at the District Council Offices, 318 Main Street, Stenhousemuir.

Each copy of the proposals so deposited is available for inspection by the public, free of charge at the places mentioned above between the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays inclusive each week for six weeks from the date hereof.

Any objection or representation with reference to the proposals must be made in writing to the Secretary of State before the Fourteenth day of August Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-four. The objection or representation must state the ground on which it is made and should be addressed to the Secretary, Scottish Development Department, St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh 1. Any person making such an objection or representation may, by sending to the County Clerk, County Offices, Viewforth, Stirling, a request in writing specifying therein an address for service, require the County Clerk to serve him with a notice of the eventual amendment to the Development Plan.
