THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Section 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act, 1958.

viz.: The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 3) Order 1965.

This Order varies the rates of drawback of import duty on—

- (i) certain imported hazelnuts used in the manufacture for export of specified hazelnut products, and
- (ii) certain imported square sawn wood and imported wooden veneer sheets used in the manufacture for export of specified sewing machine woodwork.

The Order comes into operation on the 7th April 1965 and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1965, No. 699.

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958 viz.: The Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order, 1965.

This Order provides for amendments to the Customs Tariff in respect of—

- (1) derivatives of certain compounds of organic chemicals,
- (2) certain lacquers, and
- (3) brush and broom handles of wood.

The effect is to correct errors in the Tariff which have recently come to light in order to restore the intended rates of import duty.

The Order comes into operation on the 7th April 1965 and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1965, No. 700.
