Price Determination by the Iron and Steel Board

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that the Iron and Steel Board have, pursuant to section 8 of the Iron and Steel Act, 1953, by an instrument in writing which will be known as Iron and Steel Board Price Determination 1965, No. 3, varied the Iron and Steel Board Price Determination 1965, No. 2.

The new Determination, which comes into effect on the 1st July 1965, increases the maximum prices which may be charged in the United Kingdom by iron and steel producers for Cold Reduced Tinplate. Full details are given in the new Related Schedule No. 21A, Cold Reduced Tinplate and Blackplate.
