IMPOSITION OF 40 m.p.h. SPEED LIMIT

THE Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be that the length of trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Notice shall become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.

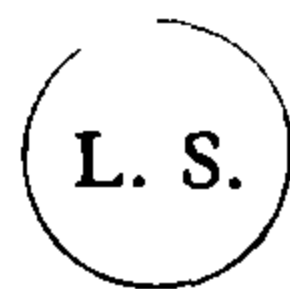
