WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959
KEG AND DRUM WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN)

THE Keg and Drum Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for [1] varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Keg and Drum) Order 1964 'Order K.D. [75]); [2] amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Keg and Drum) [Holidays] Order 1965 Order K.D. [78]); and (3) the revocation of Order K.D. [75].

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 4th February 1966. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Keg and Drum Wages Council 'Great Britain', Ebury Bridge House, Ebury Bridge Road, London S.W.1. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.

NEW TOWNS ACT, 1946
Draft Designation Order under Section I
New Town (Irvine) Designation Order, 1966

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that the Secretary of State for Scotland, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section I of, and the First Schedule to, the New Towns Act, 1946, as applied to Scotland by Section 25 of that Act has prepared and is about to consider the draft of an Order designating as the site of a proposed new town an area of land extending to 13,700 acres or thereby in the Parishes of Dreghorn, Dundonald, Irvine and Kilwinning in the County of Ayr, and shown within the inner edge of a red shaded line on the Map referred to in the draft Order.

Copies of the draft Order, together with copies of the Map and Statement indicating the size and general character of the proposed new town, have been deposited at the following offices, and may be inspected there without payment of fee between the hours of 10 a.m.-4 pm. Mondays to Fridays: County Buildings, Ayr; Council Chambers, Irvine; Council Chambers, Kilmarnock; Town Clerk's

Office, Kilwinning; Office of the Town Clerk of Stevenston, Bank of Scotland Buildings, Saltcoats; Ayr District Council Offices, The Cross, Prestwick; District Council Offices, Irane; District Council Offices, Kilmarnock, and St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh 1.

Any objections to the proposed Order must be made in writing, stating the grounds of the objection, and lodged with the Secretary of State for Scotland, St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh 1, before the 7th day of March 1966.

In accordance with Paragraph 5 of the First Schedule of the Act, any person who duly makes an objection may, at the time of making it, or thereafter, send to the Secretary of State a request in writing to be served with a notice of the making of the Order.

If any objection is duly made to the proposed Order and is not withdrawn the Secretary of State must, before making the Order, cause a Public Local Inquiry to be held with respect to the objection, and must consider the report of the person by whom the inquiry was held.
