

SCHEDULE

The Order will provide for an extension of the existing one-way traffic system and prohibition or restriction on waiting and on loading and unloading on the following streets or lengths of streets:

I. *One Way Traffic.*

1. West Princes Street from its junction with Watergate to Bishop Street. From West to East.
2. Store Lane to Watergate. From North to South then West.
3. Deanhood Place, entire length. From South to North.

II. *Waiting Prohibited—No Restriction on Hours for Loading and Unloading, Etc.*

1. Watergate (both sides) between its junction with Castle Street and its junction with West Princes Street.
2. Watergate (East side) between its junction with West Princes Street and its junction with Albert Place.
3. High Street (West side) from its junction with Victoria Street and its junction with Eden Drive.
4. East Princes Street (North side) Albert Place (North side) Victoria Street (North side) Argyle Street (North side) and Argyle Place (North side) ending at Skeoch Wood.
5. West Princes Street, (South side) entire length.
6. Guildford Square, (South side) entire length.
7. Bridgend Street, (both sides) entire length.
8. Hillhouse Road, (both sides) entire length.
9. Columhill Street (East side) from its junction with Hillhouse Road to its junction with Ladeside Street.
10. Columhill Street (both sides) from its junction with Ladeside Street to its junction with Barone Road.
11. Russell Street, (both sides) entire length.
12. Mill Street, (both sides), from its junction with Union Street to its junction with Barone Road.
13. Barone Road, (both sides) from its junction with Columhill Street to its junction with Meadows Road.
14. Castle Street (South side) entire length.
15. Castlehill Street (North side) entire length.
16. Mill Street, (both sides) from its junction with Stuart Street to its junction with John Street.

III. *Waiting Prohibited—Hours Prohibited for Loading and Unloading from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.*

1. Montague Street (South side) between its junction with Watergate and its junction with Gallowgate.
2. Deanhood Place, (both sides), entire length.
3. Gallowgate, (both sides), entire length.

IV. *Waiting Permitted (AZ Minute Limit) Hours Prohibited for Loading and Unloading from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.*

Montague Street (North side) between its junction with Watergate and its junction with Gallowgate.

V. *Waiting Permitted (30 Minute Limit) No Restriction on Hours of Loading and Unloading, Etc.*

1. High Street (East side) from its junction with Victoria Street to its junction with Eden Drive.
2. East Princes Street (South side), Albert Place (South side), Victoria Street (South side), Argyle Street (South side) and Argyle Place (South side) ending at Skeoch Wood.
3. West Princes Street (North side) entire length.
4. Columhill Street (West side) from its junction with Hillhouse Road to its junction with Ladeside Street.
