
(iii) Prohibiting the waiting of vehicles between the hours of $8 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. and $7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. in the various roads in the Burgh of Inverness specified in the First Column infra on the sides and lengths specified opposite said roads in the Second Column infra for a longer period than 30 minutes or if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle.

Roads in the Burgh of Inverness

1. Queensgate
2. Church Street
. Academy Street
Sides and Lengths on which Waitiing Prohibited for a Longer Period than Thirty Minutes between

8 a.m. and 7 p.m.
South side throughout its entire length, excluding a distance of 15 yards opposite the Queensgate Arcade Entrance.
(a) West side from its junction with Fraser Street to its junction with Friars Lane excluding a distance of 36 yards opposite Church Lane.
(b) East side from its junction with Queensgate to No. 112 Church Street excluding a distance of 25 yards across its junction with School Lane.
(a) West side from its junction with Inglis Street and Hamilton Street to No. 103 Academy Street excluding a distance of 15 yards opposite to the Market Entry and a distance of 5 yards opposite the Showroom Entrance at No. 79 Academy Street, and
(b) East side from its junction with Inglis Street and Hamilton Street to No. 112 Academy Street excluding the stances for Hackney Carriages at its junction with Margaret Street and Strother's Lane.
4. Union Street ... ... ... ... Both sides throughout its entire length excluding on the north side a distance of 11 yards opposite the Marker Entry.
(iv) Nothing in the Order shall prevent any person from causing or permiting a vehicle to wait in the lengths and sides referred to supra for so long as may be necessary:
(a) To enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
b) To enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
(c) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic etc., the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraphic Act, 1878.
