(iv) Nothing in the Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths and sides referred to supra for so long as may be necessary:

- (a) To enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
- b) To enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
- (c) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic etc., the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraphic Act, 1878.
