

SCHEDULE

I. MAIN STREET (South Side)—

- a From a point seven yards west of the 'bus stop on the south side of the street immediately east of Dundas Street to a point twenty-five yards east of the west gable of the property at the corner of Bank Street and East Main Street.
- (b) From a point ten yards west of the gable of the building at the corner of High Street and East Main Street (South Side) to its junction with High Street.

II. MAIN STREET (North Side)—

From a line drawn across the road seven yards west of the 'bus stop on the south side of Main Street immediately east of Dundas Street, eastwards, to the junction with High Street.
