

- (2) revises the definitions of certain textile articles eligible for drawback of import duty, so as to correspond with a modified basis of determining their liability to import duty;
- (3) provides for the allowance of drawback of import duty on hops when exported in the packages in which they were imported; and
- (4) revokes the existing rates of drawback of import duty in respect of the following exported goods manufactured from the imported materials shown, and provides for drawback to be related to the duty paid on the quantity of imported materials actually used in their manufacture:

Exported goods	Imported materials
Casings for sausages and prepared meats	Tubing of poly(vinyl chloride), regenerated cellulose or impregnated or coated vegetable fibre paper.
Cinematograph film, exposed	Unexposed film.
Cocoa and chocolate and products and manufactures thereof	Cocoa beans, cocoa butter and cocoa paste.
Coffee beans and ground coffee, roasted, and soluble coffee powder	Coffee beans.
Laminated glass	Poly(vinyl butyral) sheet.
Whey powder products	Whey powder.

#### PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 JOB EVALUATION SCHEMES

*Direction under section 5(4) further extending the period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their report.*

1. WHEREAS the First Secretary of State and the Minister of Labour, in pursuance of their powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the above-mentioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and have published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 23rd March 1967;

2. And whereas by section 5(3) of the Act, but subject to section 5(4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;

3. And whereas, in pursuance of their powers under the said section 5(4), the First Secretary of State and the Minister of Labour, by a direction published in the Gazette on 20th June 1967, extended the said period of three months by six months, and the Secretary of State for Economic Affairs and the Minister of Labour, by a direction published in the Gazette on 22nd December 1967, further extended the said period of three months by three months, and by a direction published in the Gazette on 21st March 1968, further extended the said period of three months by one month, and by a direction published in the Gazette on 19th April 1968, further extended the said period of three months by two months;

4. Now therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5(4), hereby directs that the said period of three months be further extended by six weeks.
