CALLING IN ALL FARTHINGS, HALFPENNIES AND HALF-CROWNS IN GIBRALTAR

We, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Coinage Act 1870, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, call in, in Gibraltar, the following coins by the dates respectively specified:

- (a) all farthings by the thirty-first day of July One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine;
- (b) all halfpennies by the thirty-first day of July One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine; and
- (c) all half-crowns by the thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine,

and direct that, after those respective dates, those coins shall not be current or legal tender within Gibraltar.

This Proclamation shall be published in the Official Gazette of Gibraltar.

Given at Our Court at Arundel Park, this thirty-first day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the eighteenth year of Our Reign.
