The National Insurance (Classification) Amendment Regulations 1969

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the National Insurance (Classification) Regulations 1948 by including among employments in respect of which persons are treated as employed persons, employment as a clerk, secretary, typist or bookkeeper or in any similar capacity or as a telephonist or office machine operator where the persons employed are supplied by or through the agency of a third person and do not render their services on their own premises and where the remuneration is paid by or through, or on the basis of accounts submitted by such third person, and by prescribing such third person as the employer of the persons so employed.

HARBOURS ACT 1964

SCRABSTER HARBOUR

NOTICE is hereby given that the Trustees of the Harbour of Scrabster have applied to the Secretary of State to make a Harbour Revision Order under section 14 of the Harbours Act 1964.

The objects of the proposed Order are to authorise the Trustees of the Harbour of Scrabster to provide, operate and maintain a fish market and facilities for a box pool at the fish market and to make charges and byelaws in respect thereof. The Order also empowers the Trustees to appoint a person or persons to superintend the traffic within the market and to carry out the regulations, byelaws and orders of the Trustees thereat, to lease the fish market and enter into agreements with respect to offices, stalls and ancillary buildings, to extend the borrowing powers and raise the limit on the borrowing powers of the Trustees from £31,000 to £100,000.

A copy of the draft Order which accompanied the application may be seen at all reasonable hours at the offices of the undermentioned Solicitors and Notaries Public and Parliamentary Agents.

Any person desiring to make to the Secretary of State objection to the application should write to the Secretary of State, Department of Agriculture and Fisheries for Scotland (Room 60), St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh EH1 3DA stating the grounds of his objection within 42 days from the 15th day of October 1969.
