*The County of Stirling (Various Streets, Larbert) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970*

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that the County Council of the County of Stirling propose to make an Order in terms of Sub-sections (1), (2), (3) and (3c) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, to prohibit vehicles other than public service vehicles from waiting at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order will provide for exceptions to enable a vehicle to wait if it is being used in connection with building operations, demolitions, road maintenance, cleansing, postal, fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

General medical practitioners and disabled drivers will not be affected by the proposals.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned not later than twenty-one days from the date hereof.

A copy of the Order and relative plan can be inspected during normal office hours at the County Offices, Viewforth, Stirling and District Council Offices, Stenhousemuir.

## SCHEDULE

<i>Road at Larbert in the Parish of Larbert and County of Stirling</i>	<i>Side and section of road on which waiting is prohibited</i>
i. Muirhall Road (Class III)	On both sides thereof from its junction with Bellsdyke Road A.876 to a point Three hundred and forty yards South of its junction with Pembroke Street (Unclassified). On the East side thereof from its junction with Main Street B.905 for a distance of sixty yards Northwards and on the West side thereof from its junction with Main Street B.905 for a distance of one hundred yards Northwards.
ii. Pembroke Street (Unclassified)	On both sides thereof from its junction with Muirhall Road (Class III) Eastwards to its junction with George Street (Unclassified).
iii. Main Street B.905	On the South side thereof from a point seventy-five yards North East of its junction with South Broomage Avenue (Unclassified) South Westwards for a distance of One hundred and sixty-seven yards and on the North side thereof from a point forty yards North East of its junction with Muirhall Road (Class III) in a South Westerly direction to its junction with Foundry Loan (Unclassified).

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that the County Council of the County of Stirling propose to make an Order in terms of sub-sections (1), (2), (3) and (3c) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, to prohibit vehicles other than public service vehicles from waiting (i) at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule I hereto and (ii) for a period longer than twenty minutes in any period of one hour in the length of road specified in Schedule II hereto.

The Order will provide for exceptions to enable a vehicle to wait if it is being used in connection with building operations, demolitions, road maintenance, cleansing, postal, firebrigade, ambulance or police purposes.

General medical practitioners and disabled drivers will not be affected by the proposals.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned not later than twenty-one days from the date hereof.

## SCHEDULE I

<i>Road at Bannockburn in the Parish of St. Ninians and County of Stirling</i>	<i>Side and section of road on which waiting is prohibited at any time</i>
(i) East Murrayfield (Unclassified)	On both sides thereof from its junction with the Edinburgh-Perth Trunk Road A.9 for a distance of thirty-five yards.
(ii) Main Street (Unclassified)	On the South side thereof from a point seventy-seven yards East of its junction with West Murrayfield (Unclassified) to its junction with the Edinburgh-Perth Trunk Road A.9 for a distance of one hundred and eighty yards Westwards.

## SCHEDULE II

<i>Road at Bannockburn in the Parish of St. Ninians and County of Stirling</i>	<i>Side and section of road on which waiting is limited to twenty minutes in any one hour</i>
Main Street (Unclassified)	On the South side thereof from its junction with West Murrayfield (Unclassified) to a point seventy-seven yards Eastwards
