Prices and Incomes Act 1966  
THE PAY AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF  
WORKERS IN LAUNDRIES AND DRY CLEANERS

Direction under Section 5(4) extending the period within which The National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their Report.

1. WHEREAS the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the above-mentioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and has published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 22nd May 1970.
2. And, whereas by section 5(3) of the Act, but subject to section 5(4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date.
3. Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of his powers under the said section 5(4), hereby directs that the said period of three months be extended by three months.
