SCHEDULE

The effect of the County of Stirling (Avondale Road, Reddoch Road and Newlands Road) (Restrictions on Driving) Order 1970, is that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven on the lengths of roads indicated in Column 1 any vehicle the weight of which exceeds that stated in Column 2.

(i) Avondale Road (Unclassified) from its junction with Bo'ness Road B.904 to its junction with the Edinburgh-Perth Trunk Road A.9 in the Parish of Grangemouth and the County of Stirling.	Vehicles over 5 tons laden weight.
(ii) Reddoch Road (Unclassified) from its junction with Bo'ness Road B.904 to the point at which it intersects the Burgh boundary of Grangemouth in the Parish of Grangemouth and the County of Stirling.	All vehicles over 3 tons unladen weight.
(iii) Newlands Road (Icehouse Brae) (Unclassified) from its junction with Zetland Drive (Unclassified) at Laurieston to the point at which it intersects the Burgh boundary of Grangemouth in the Parish of Falkirk and the County of Stirling.	All vehicles over 3 tons unladen weight.

THE COUNTY OF STIRLING (DRUMQUHASSLE AND GARTNESS ROAD, GARTOCHARN ROAD AND BARNFORD ROAD) (RESTRICTIONS ON DRIVING) ORDER 1970

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of the County of Stirling made an Order at their Meeting on 24th September 1970, in terms of sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is detailed in the Schedule hereto.

The Order provides for exceptions in the case of vehicles being used in connection with:—

- (a) The conveyance of persons or goods to and from premises situated on the affected lengths of road.
- (b) Agriculture on or the transport of timber from land adjacent to the affected lengths of road and where necessary in connection with:—
- (c) The maintenance of the roads and telegraphic lines.
- (d) The supply of gas, electricity and water.

SCHEDULE

The effect of the County of Stirling (Drumquhassle and Gartness Road, Gartocharn Road and Barnford Road) (Restrictions on Driving) Order 1970, is that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven on the lengths of road indicated in Column 1 any vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds that stated in Column 2.

All vehicles over 3 tons unladen weight.
(ii) Gartocharn Road (Class III) from its junction with Stirling-Dumbarton Road A.811 to its junction with the Drumquhassle and Gartness Road (Class III) in the Parish of Drymen and County of Stirling.	All vehicles over 3 tons unladen weight.
(iii) Barnford Road (Unclassified) from its junction with the Glasgow-Aberfoyle Road A.81 in the Parish of Killearn to its junction with Drumquhassle and Gartness Road (Class III) in the Parish of Drymen, both in the County of Stirling.	All vehicles over 3 tons unladen weight.
